Essex

The 50th Essex Summer School takes place between 10 July and 18 August 2017. The Summer School consists of three two-week sessions. Each session offers a variety of post graduate level courses. Courses usually run for two weeks, infrequent exceptions run for one week only. Courses cover various types of quantitative and qualitative research methods, research design, techniques for data collection and measurement as well as mathematics.

Eastern Finland

The Summer School runs between 14-25 August 2017 (two weeks) both at the Joensuu and Kuopio campuses. All the courses offered are credit-bearing and typically carry 5 ECTS/course. The courses are aimed at Master's level students in particular, and the language of instruction is English. Students completing a course will be issued an official transcript and a certificate of attendance. Courses cover a wide range of topics from global media to food law or Bioinformatics.
